




May 7th Presentation and Old Historic Short Films

James Z. Holot, a local amateur historian and expert metal detectorist, will be presenting his interesting discoveries at this meeting. James is a 10th Grade Honors Student at Hunterdon Central Regional High School where he recently received the Student of the Month Award (March 2022).

The 16-year-old has been interested in local history ever since he heard Mr Richard Stothoff present "The Skirmish at Geary's Ridge" during Hunterdon County's 300-year Anniversary celebration in 2014.
