

Message from the Tax Collector ...

RARITAN TOWNSHIP PROPERTY TAX DUE DATE HAS NOT BEEN EXTENDED.

THE DUE DATE IS MAY 1ST WITH A GRACE PERIOD UNTIL MAY 11TH.

The Governor's Executive Order allows for the Municipality to extend the deadline and does not mandate it. This Order does not reflect the fact that the Municipality is still required to fulfill its statutory obligation to make quarterly payments to the schools, which account for approximately 68% of your taxes and approximately 20% to the County. Without the timely collection of property tax payments, the Township will not be able to meet these statutory requirements without borrowing money to do so. This will result in even higher costs to the tax payer. If the Order also provided for the same delay in the Township's statutory payments to the schools and County, then the Township could extend the deadline without incurring debt.

In an effort to stop the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19), the Tax Collectors office will be temporarily closed to the public. You may pay your taxes in person by utilizing our drop box located outside of our building, by mail or online at www.Raritan-Township.com

Senior freeze applications are not due until November 2nd 2020. Please be advised that we can only fill out applications if they are sent to us by mail or left in our drop box located outside of our building. We will return the completed form to you by mail. For those of you who do not wish to mail or leave your senior freeze forms with us, please visit us when our offices re-open to the public. Again, the applications are not due to the State of New Jersey until November 2nd 2020.
