**A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO JEN ELECTRIC, INC.  
FOR TRAFFIC SIGNAL UPGRADES**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Raritan is in need of upgrading the traffic signals at the intersections of Case Boulevard and Voorhees Corner Road and Barley Sheaf and Voorhees Corner Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Raritan is a member of the Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council (MCCPC); and

**WHEREAS**, Jen Electric Inc., 631 Morris Avenue, Springfield, New Jersey, 07081 has been awarded contract #37 Traffic Signal Maintenance & Repairs through the MCCPC; and

**WHEREAS**, the Superintendent of Public Works recommends that Jen Electric, Inc., be awarded the contract for traffic signal upgrades; and

**WHEREAS**, the cost of this will be at the bid price as documented by the MCCPC and appropriated through Ordinance #18-20 in the amount of \$18,637.99; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that funds are available through Certificate of Availability of Funds # 18-21 for traffic signal upgrades.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Raritan, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey that the contract for traffic signal upgrades at the intersections of Case Boulevard and Voorhees Corner Road and Barley Sheaf and Voorhees Corner Road be awarded to Jen Electric Inc., 631 Morris Avenue, Springfield New Jersey, 07081 in the amount of \$18,637.99.
