**APPOINTING JENNIFER TOTH, ESQUIRE
AS ACTING MUNICIPAL PUBLIC DEFENDER**

WHEREAS, the Township Code, Chapter 2.64 Pursuant to P.L. 1997 c.256 of the Township of Raritan stipulates that the Township Committee of the Township of Raritan shall appoint a Municipal Public Defender whose duty is to represent eligible, indigent defendants charged in a Court with a crime as specified in N.J.S.A. 2B:12-18 or if in the opinion of the Court there is a likelihood that the defendant, if convicted of any other offense, will be subject to imprisonment or other consequence of magnitude; and

WHEREAS, there exists a temporary vacancy for Municipal Public Defender for the Court beginning January 1, 2019 and terminating February 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee wishes to fill this temporary vacancy; and

WHEREAS, Jennifer Toth, Esquire, Attorney at Law in the State of New Jersey, duly licensed and in good standing before the Supreme Court of New Jersey, has agreed to this temporary appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and the Township Committee of the Township of Raritan, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey hereby appoints Jennifer Toth of Winegar, Wilhelm, Glynn and Roemersma, 305 Roseberry Street, Phillipsburg, New Jersey, 08865 as Acting Municipal Public Defender beginning January 1, 2019 and terminating February 1, 2019.


