NEW BUSINESS

**a. BLOCK 79.04, LOT 4 (24 GLENN ROAD) – SEPTIC SYSTEM ALTERATION
WAIVER REQUEST**

Alex Mikos, Goldenbaum Baill Engineering, Inc., presented the waiver request.

Motion was made by Zak, seconded by Sollena to approve the requested waiver with conditions as follows:

1. A disposal bed of 81.1 feet from the existing well which does not meet the minimum 100-foot setback requirement by code. As per 7:9A-4.3, the distance can be reduced to 50 feet provided there is 50 feet of casing in the well.
2. As no record exists for the well at the Division of Public Health, the applicant shall provide a report from a well driller to determine how much casing is in the well. If the casing does not meet the requirements, then an ultra violet device shall be installed on the well.
3. In addition, if the casing does not meet the requirements, the applicant shall submit a before and after water testing report to the Division of Public Health indicating passing results.
4. Raritan Township Board of Health grants authorization to the Division of Public Health to approve said waiver upon compliance of conditions regarding well requirements.

This is based on a letter from Dawn Faltings of the Hunterdon County Division of Public Health dated June 27, 2018.

Louis Reiner expressed his opinion in opposition to medical and recreational marijuana use in the municipality.


