



The United States Census Bureau is the federal government's largest statistical agency dedicated to providing current facts and figures about people, places and economy in the U.S.

The U.S. Constitution mandates that a complete count be taken every 10 years of every person living in the 50 states, District of Columbia and the five U.S. territories.

April 1, 2020 is Census Day.

Participation is critical. The data collected:

- * Determines how many representatives each state gets in Congress
- * Determines how much federal funding each state receives
- * Is used to redraw district boundaries

Data is private and protected and cannot be shared with law enforcement or other governmental agencies.

In mid-March, households will receive detailed information on how to respond to the 2020 Census survey online, by phone (in 12 different languages), or by mail. Only 1 person must respond per household.
