- a. **BLOCK 60, LOT 53 (4 HILLSIDE ROAD) – SEPTIC SYSTEM WAIVER REQUEST**

Bill Jupinka, Bayer-Risse Engineering presented the waiver request.

Motion was made by Lanka, seconded by Morlando to approve the following requested waiver:

1. The proposed disposal bed at 75 feet from the existing well which does not meet the minimum 100-foot setback requirement by code. Per N.J.A.C. 7:9A-4.3, the distance may be reduced by the administrative authority to a minimum of 50 feet provided that there is 50 feet of casing in the well.

As no record exists for the well at the Hunterdon County Department of Health, the Board approved the waiver with the requirement that an ultra violet device be installed on the well along with a water passing test for Coliform after treatment.

This is based on a letter from Robert Vaccarella of the Hunterdon County Department of Health dated May 12, 2020.

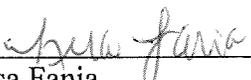
ADJOURNMENT
