**A RESOLUTION CANCELING FUNDED BALANCES IN
CAPITAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
RARITAN, IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, NEW
JERSEY**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
RARITAN, IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Mayor and Committee of the Township of Raritan, in the County of Hunterdon, New Jersey (the "Township") previously adopted Bond Ordinances for the purpose of funding various capital projects and improvements of the Township as more fully specified in the Bond Ordinances. And as of the date hereof, the projects have been completed and funded/unfunded balances remain open and unexpended as described below are hereby cancelled in the amounts set forth therein.

Section 2. The funded balances in the aggregate amount of \$20,958.45 shall be transferred to capital surplus.

Section 3. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this resolution to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes or amounts authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
